At today's opening ceremony, the IIW Awards will also be presented. No less than four German engineers can look forward to these Awards:

- Evgeny Paton Prize:
 - Professor Dr.-Ing. Michael Gehde, Institut für Fördertechnik und Kunststoffe der TU Chemnitz
- Walter Edström Medal:
 - Dipl.-Ing. Christian Ahrens, International Welding Consultant (CA-IWC), Duisburg
- World Best Paper Award for year 2020 in Category B:
 - Dr.-Ing. Arne Kromm, Bundesanstalt für Materialforschung und -prüfung (BAM), Berlin
- World Best Paper Award for year 2020 in Category C:
 Dipl.-Ing. Andreas Deinböck, Institut für Maschinelle Anlagentechnik und Betriebsfestigkeit (IMAB) der TU Clausthal

The Heinz Sossenheimer Software Innovation Award, presented by DVS, will go to Feng Zhili and his team from Oak Ridge National Laboratory/USA. The award recognizes contributions to modeling and simulation software in a joining technology field that help to improve work quality and safety.

Due to the ongoing corona pandemic and the good experience with the digital format of the event, the IIW had decided for the "on-line" version for the second time. The IIW delegates and interested parties from the joining industry from all over the world can expect an extensive program in addition to the opening and closing ceremony and as well the award ceremony.
